“Judge Not?” – Matthew 7.1-6

1. It is important to maintain good judgment.
2. It is wrong to condemn or to judge others inappropriately.
3. **“Do not judge others” does not mean, “Always agree with others.”**

LifeConnect Group Discussion Questions

- What connection is Jesus making in Matthew 7.1-6 between the faults we notice in others and our own problems? For those who do ‘see clearly’, what is the meaning of Jesus’ warning in verse 6?
- Why does Jesus introduce dogs and pigs into this passage about judging? How are pigs and dogs different today than they were in Jesus’ time?
- Take some time to pray and ask the Lord to reveal to you situations in which you have pointed out the speck and missed the log. How can you make amends? (See Matthew 18.15-17.)
